Double master & degree programme between the University of Padova and the University of Wroclaw in the field of International Relations A.Y. 2020/2021

Foreword

The official source of the Call is õBando di concorso per 5 posti scambio presso l¢Università di Wroclaw (Uniwersytetem Wroclawskim), in Polonia nell¢ambito del percorso internazionale in õHuman Rights and Multi-level Governanceö per il rilascio del doppio titolo a.a. 2020/2021ö in Italian. This translated version is intended only for a better comprehension. For legal purposes, the parties should refer only to the Italian version of the Call.

Art. 1 ó Exchange

The University of Padua, within the framework of the cooperation agreement signed with the Wroclaw University (Uniwersytetem Wroclawskim) for the implementation of a Double Degree Master Programme in the field of International Relations, has issued an open call for application for 5 students per year, reserved to students enrolled in the first year of the Master Degree Course "Human Rights and Multi-level Governance" (LM-52) at the University of Padua, for the A.Y. 2020/2021.

Art. 2 ó Admission requirements

Students may participate in the selection if they are in one of the following conditions by the deadline of the call:

have obtained a First Cycle Degree;

be regularly enrolled in the Masterøs degree in Human Rights and Multi-level Governance;

have obtained at least 63 ECTS credits at the beginning of the second year, according to the scheme in Annex II;

have an adequate knowledge of English language.

The admission of students with less than 63 ECTS credits will be subject to an additional assessment by the Academic Board of the University of Wroclaw.

Art. 3 ó Application procedure

Applicants must submit the documents listed below no later than 28th February 2020 (h. 1pm), using the application form in Annex I.

The application form and the documents can be:

As part of the procedural information, in making the application, the candidate takes personal responsibility for declarations in relation to his personal details, place and date of birth, residential address, telephone/cell number, elected domicile for the purposes of this selection, and e-mail address.

To the application, the students must enclose, under penalty of exclusion, all the following documents:

Self-certification of the enrollment at the Masterøs degree, with the list of the passed exams with marks and credits;

Motivation letter;

Curriculum vitae (http://europass.cedefop.europa.eu/en/documents/curriculum-vitae);

Photocopy of a valid Passport or Identity card;

Other academic qualifications relevant for the candidate.

All incomplete applications (lack of information or faulty of attachment of documents by the candidate) and applications received after the set deadlines will be rejected.

Art. 4 ó Selection criteria

Students selection will be based on the following criteria:

- □ Weighted average of the grades of the exams taken in the master's degree course
- □ Other academic qualifications obtained;
- Motivation letter;
- Curriculum vitae;
- □ Knowledge of English language;
- □ Knowledge of a second language (optional);
- □ Knowledge of Polish language (optional).

A Commission appointed by the HRG Council will do the selection. Students shall be present at the meeting scheduled on 11th March 2020 at 12.00 pm in the Office of Prof Paolo De Stefani in via del Santo 77, 1st floor, with their ID card.

Candidates who will not take part in the selection will be automatically excluded from the final ranking.

Art. 5 ó Selection procedure and ranking

Studentsøapplications will be evaluated according to the following criteria:

- From 0 to 30 points: weighted average marks;
- > From 0 to 5 points: other academic qualifications;
- > From 0 to 40 points: motivation letter, curriculum and interview;
- > From 0 to 10 points: knowledge of English language;
- From 0 to 10 points: knowledge of a second language;
- > From 0 to 5 points: Knowledge of Polish language.

To be admitted to the double degree programme candidates must obtain at least 60 points out of 100.

The ranking list will be published at the Internationalization Office of the Department of Political Science, Law and International Studies, via del Santo 28 ó 1st floor, and on the web page http://www.spgi.unipd.it/didattica/mobilita-internazionale/doppio-diploma on 16th March 2020.

The winning candidates must present themselves at the place and time reported in the final ranking list for formal acceptance, according to the form specially prepared by the competent office. In case of non-acceptance within the fixed term, the candidate, will be replaced by the next-ranked candidate, according to their positioning on the final ranking list.

Art. 6 ó Funding

Students will receive a scholarship from specific University funds according to the effective number of days spent at the host university (max 12 months ó 360 days). Before leaving, students will sign a financial contract, which will define the amount and the disbursement methods.

At the end of the mobility, students will be asked to write a brief report on the activities carried out.

The scholarship is strictly connected to the participation to the programme and the attainment of the two degrees. In case of interruption of mobility, students will be asked to reimburse the scholarship. In particular:

- In case of withdrawal within 3 months, students will be asked to reimburse the entire sum;
- In case of interruption after 3 months, students will receive only the sum corresponding to the exact number of days spent abroad.

Selected students are exempted from paying fees at the host university, but they should be regularly enrolled at the University of Padova and therefore continue to pay its fees.

Art. 7 ó Study Plan

In agreement with the professors of Padua and with the host institution, the winning students must prepare before the departure and, if necessary, promptly update after the departure, the learning agreement containing the exams to take abroad.

In order to obtain the double degree, students must acquire 63 ECTS credits in Padua and 63 ECTS credit in Wroclaw, in total 126 ECTS credits (including 18 ECTS credits of the final examination). The study plan is defined in the Annex II.

All the courses at the Wroclaw University will be taught in English.
