IAI and International Tribunal on Evictions (ITE), Tunisia

Soha is a polyvalent artist (painting, ceramics, sculpture, engraving) based in Tunis and active worldwide. Her international involvement dates to 1995, when she coordinated women witnesses from Morocco and Mauritania to the International Tribunal on Violence against Women at the NGO Forum parallel of the World Conference on Women, Beijing.

Soha is currently coordinator of the International Tribunal on Evictions (ITE). She organized the ITE East Asia 2016, the ITE in Quito 2016 (parallel event of Habitat III), the ITE 2017 in Venice on Tourism, the ITE 2018 in Salvador de Bahia (at the World Social Forum), and two ITE 2019 sessions on Climate change, in Santiago de Chile and in Madrid (parallel event of COP 25).
